Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) How do you qualify to be a Fellow?
 - a) Accomplished instructors & educational professionals with strong leadership potential, high-impact & an interest in learning/sharing new insights in the bioscience industry.
 - b) Currently in good standing with their home institution.
 - c) Nominated by their administration.
 - d) Fellows must exhibit a willingness to share data on the outcomes of this experience.
- 2) How do I apply?
 - a) Complete an application at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/3VL2N32>
 - b) Submit a current resume and two letters of reference.
 - c) Telephone interview with Selection Committee
- 3) Is there compensation for participants?

In addition to meals, transportation, and lodging, a weekly training stipend of \$350 will be awarded to Fellows who qualify.
- 4) Is past training in the biosciences required?

No. All disciplines are encouraged, but an interest in science and laboratory applications is required.
- 5) When and where will this Fellowship occur?

The Fellowship Project will be held in North Carolina from June 5th- June 29th 2017. Fellows will participate in laboratory "boot camps" at 3 of NC's community colleges, and visit multiple educational institutions and industry sites.
