# Using Biological Research to Reduce or Reverse the Effects of Aging and Increase Longevity

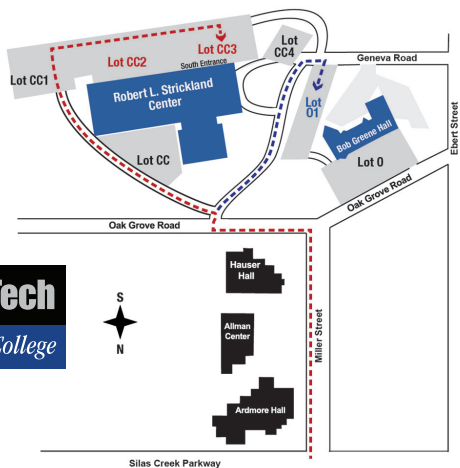
